Every qualified student desiring a quality education with a Christian perspective should discover for himself the many opportunities for personal growth and development at Methodist College. As its investment in the future leaders of our churches and communities, Methodist College offers scholarships, loans, tuition remission, campus employment and grants-in-aid as a supplement to the financial program of those students whose families, after some sacrifice, are unable to provide all the necessary funds.

Approximately 45 academic scholarships ranging from \$100 to \$600 per year are available. All scholarships are awarded for one year and are to be used exclusively for payment of college fees. The renewal of scholarships is conditional on the student's maintaining a minimum grade of C (2.0 gpa) in academic work and satisfactory records in conduct and character. Application for renewal must be filed each succeeding academic year.

Eligibility for academic scholarships vary according to individual requirements. Interested students should read thoroughly the Scholarship section of the current catalogue. In addition to taking the scholarship examination, students should submit an application for admission, verify actual need, have good high school records, have high test scores (SAT or AST) and have recommendations.

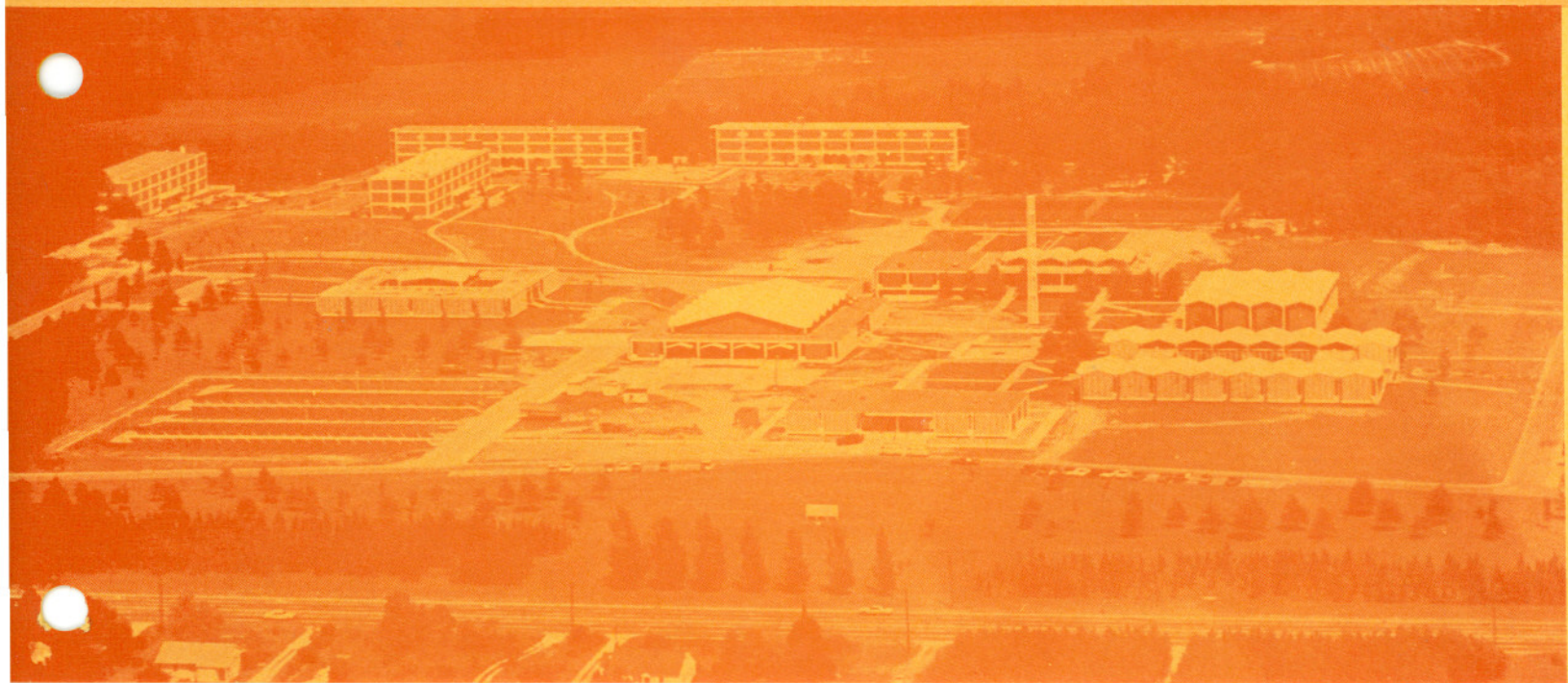
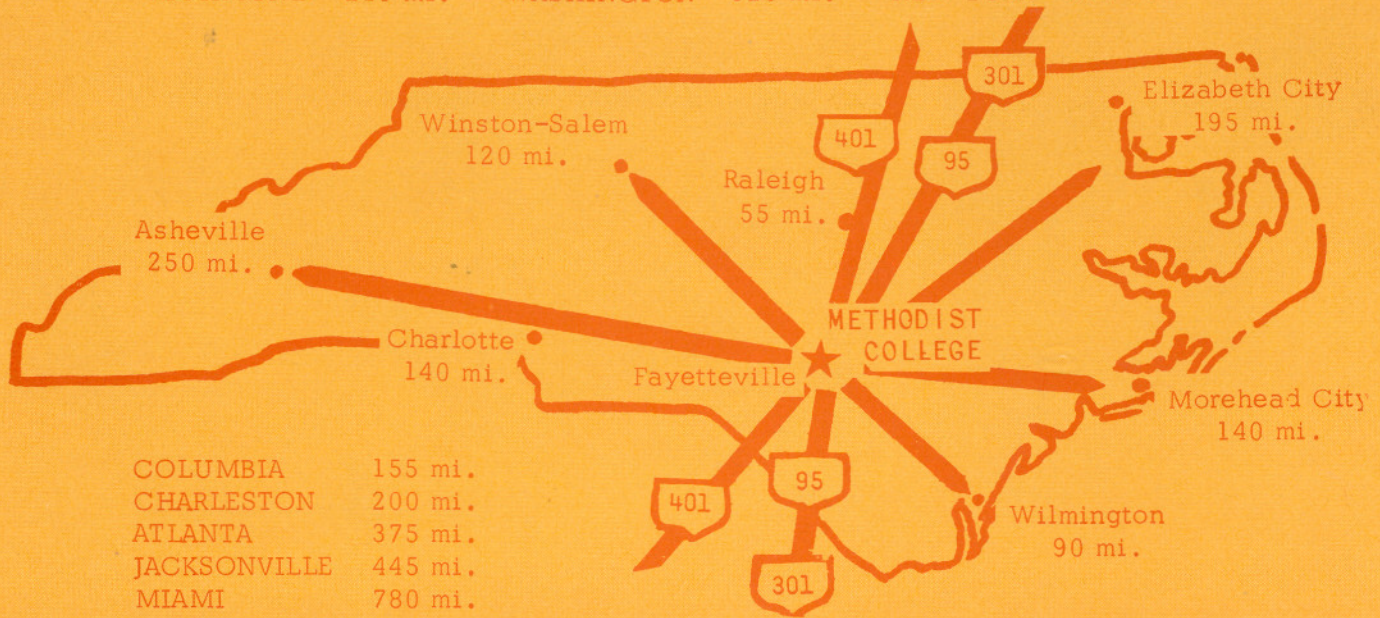
