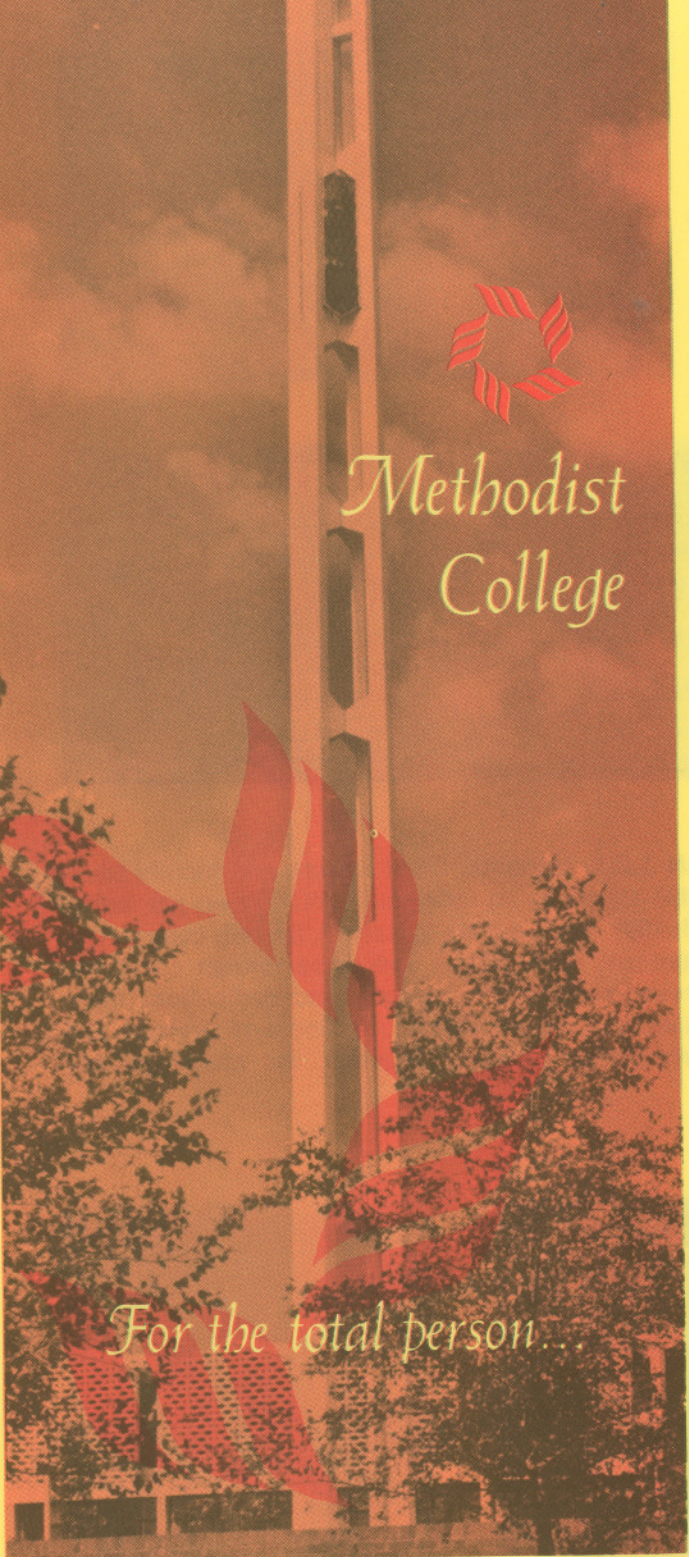
YOU'LL FIND METHODIST COLLEGE six miles north of downtown Fayetteville, North Carolina, and sixty miles south of Raleigh. Our uniquely modern campus is centered on 600 acres of rolling woodlands near the Cape Fear River. MAJORS ARE OFFERED in art, biology, chemistry, economics and business administration, elementary teacher education, English, French, history, mathematics, music, religion, sociology, Spanish, and political science. Through our teacher education program the college prepares secondary school teachers of English, French, mathematics, science, and social studies, and special teachers of general music.

FURTHER INFORMATION about Methodist College may be obtained from our Admissions Office. The college is open to all qualified students without discrimination.
