METHODIST COLLEGE STUDENT PLAYING FOR NATIONAL TENNIS HONORS

Bently Hill, a junior at Methodist College, will be entered in the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (N.A.I.A.) Tennis Tournament in Kansas City, Missouri, June 8-13. Coach Mason Sykes and Bently will depart from Grannis Field Sunday morning and will fly directly to Kansas City. Bently will start his competition Monday morning.

Bently is undefeated in college competition this season with a 18-0 record, winning both the D.I.A.C. Singles Championship as well as the District 29 Singles Championship. Coach Sykes comments, "Bently has an excellent chance to win the National honors. Being his first appearance in N.A.I.A. national tournaments, he will be paired possibly against the best competition his first couple of rounds. I think if he can win the first two days, he can win the Singles Championship. This is the first entry Methodist College has had in a national tournament, and we hope we can certainly give a fine showing."
