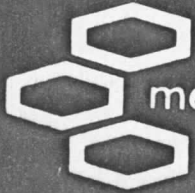

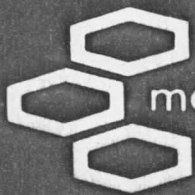

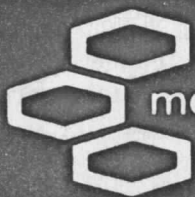

Summer school enrollment largest in five

FAYETTEVILLE _____ With less than two weeks in operation, the new tri-term Methodist College summer session can boast the largest enrollment for summer school in the past five years.

Early counts reveal nearly 600 registrations for summer school courses scheduled through August 22. College officials attribute the jump in summer school enrollment to the recently adopted three term program.

According to Director of Summer School Dr. Fred C. McDavid, "Many students find it possible to earn as many hours credit in the tri-term session as in a regular semester."

With more than 50 different courses offered, there is virtually a class being taught in every academic area of the college. Classes range from art to sociology. In addition to the term expansion from one to three, science subjects have been implemented for the first time this summer.

Taking into consideration the multiple class registrations by each student over the three term period,

this is by far the most students to be enrolled in ~~Met~~ summer school in at least five years, said one college source.

"We have students from all classifications," Dean Samuel J. Womack pointed out. Quite often local residents who go to school elsewhere take summer courses at Methodist to transfer later. Other students plan to complete their degree requirements in less than four years. Some are in the military degree completion program, some are school teachers and some are special students here to pick up a course of personal interest.

With registration still possible for the two remaining summer terms estimates are favorable for many more registrations. Students may register for term II through June 8, with term III registration to end July 13.
