
FAYETTEVILLE--Methodist College will begin its spring semester Thursday morning (Jan. 16) after the Christmas holidays break.

FAYETTEVILLE--Grants totaling more than \$47,000 are being distributed to 39 privately supported colleges and universities in North Carolina this week by The Sears-Roebuck Foundation, a spokesman said today.

In the Fayetteville area, Methodist College received a grant totaling \$2,000.

The North Carolina colleges and universities are among almost 1,000 private accredited two- and four-year institutions across the country which are sharing in \$1,300,000 in Sears Foundation funds for the 1974-75 academic year. Funds may be used unrestrictedly as the colleges and universities deem necessary.

In addition to its unrestricted grant program, The Sears-Roebuck Foundation each year conducts a variety of special-purpose programs in elementary, secondary, higher and continuing education. Altogether, the Foundation had expenditures of almost \$2,750,000 in 1974 for its educational activities.


