COLLEGE FOUNDATION PASSES \$1000000 IN CURRENT DRIVE

The month of May was a memorable one for the Methodist College Foundation.

The foundation passed the \$2 million mark in funds raised locally over the past 19 years. And the current community loyalty campaign surpassed the \$105,000 (\$105,074.99 May 18) level for the first time in 13 years, according to I. H. "Ike" O'Hanlon, 1976 loyalty campaign chairman.

In 1958 the foundation was established in Cumberland County to assist in the development of Methodist College. More than \$850,000 was raised locally to build facilities at the college, plus a donation of 600 acres of land, during the 1958-62 period.

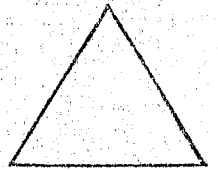
The two week program, entitled "Modern Japan: The Political Dimension," will include movies, performance of the tea ceremony, Koto recital, and guest speakers.

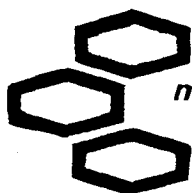

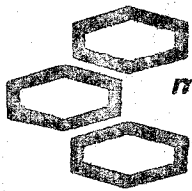

This method of course instruction has been used by Eleanor Howell, assistant professor of art, for several years and apparently works very well if the Margaret Willis school experience is typical.

"Puppetry is one of the oldest and best means of teaching," said Mrs. Howell. "In this situation we have learning by the audience and my students.

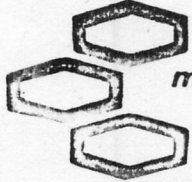
"Since each puppet is designed individually, it is a form of original sculpture. Also touched upon is composition in script writing, theatre, music and fine arts," she said.
