BEING OFFERED BY METHODIST


FAYETTEVILLE--Ten community service courses are being offered by the Methodist College continuing education division this month and next.





Grants totaling more that \$47,000 will be distributed to 29 privately supported colleges and universities in North Carolina this week by The Sears-Roebuck Foundation, a spokesman said today.

In the Fayetteville area, Methodist College will receive a grant totaling \$1,200.

The North Carolina colleges and universities are among almost 1,000 private accredited two and four-year institutions across the country which are sharing in \$1,250,000 in Sears Foundation funds for the 1976-77 academic year. Funds may be used unrestrictedly as the colleges and universities deem necessary.

In addition to its unrestricted grant program, The Sears-Roebuck Foundation each year conducts a variety of special-purpose programs in elementary, secondary, higher, and continuing education. Altogether, the Foundation had expenditures of over \$2,500,000 in 1976 for its education activities.



DONATED TO MC

FAYETTEVILLE--A bust of the Marquis de Lafayette has been donated to Methodist College by Fayetteville sculptor Fritz R. Lopez.

The bust, which was given Wednesday (Jan. 19), will be displayed in the Lafayette Room of the Davis Memorial Library. The room is a special collection of books, documents, letters and other memorabilia relating to Lafayette.

Lopez spent six months carving the bust from a black walnut tree taken from the Gray's Creek area. Actually, he carved three busts from the tree trunk; however, the first had termites, and the second had unsuitable interior wood.

The retired soldier decided to carve Lafayette because, "I've heard of Lafayette all my life, I've studied him and his career, and he's been my idol for many, many years. I admire him and what he stood for, and after awhile he sort of became part of me."

Lopez is a self-taught sculptor who uses wood (his favorite medium), stone and clay. His wife Melva, a portrait artist, has taught him about sculpture and he has read a few books by the old masters.

The bust shows Lafayette in his late 40s or early 50s, and was



The bust shows Lafayette in his late 40s or early 50s, and was based on a small photo in an encyclopedia. After the bust neared completion, Lopez sought out other paintings of the Revolutionary War hero but kept returning to the small photo he had begun with. Thus the bust is almost completely based upon this one photo.

Following the carving stage, the wood was sealed and hand polished with tung oil.

TO BE PRESENTED AT METHODIST

FAYETTEVILLE--"Echoes of the Twenties, Songs for the Seventies," an authentic German kabarett (cabaret), will be presented in the Methodist College Student Union at 7:30 p.m. Friday, February 18. There is no admission charge, and the public is invited.

This show tells the story of the 1918-1933 era during which German experienced an almost unprecedented arts explosion. One provocative art form was born: the cabaret whose intention is to give a panorama of a particular era—of its political, economic and cultural climate as expressed in the songs and scenes of cabaret, the literary, critical, satirical, provocative art form which flourished especially in that period.

German -born Herbert Nelson will give a panorama of that era with songs done by Eva Nelson. In the second part of the program the focus will shift to the 70's and the North American scene.

In songs, scenes and monologues by the Nelsons, they will spotlight, satirize and comment on trends of our time.

The story is told with the help of slides—of tapes of actual performances—songs done by Eva in the original German or in English translation—and in conference monologue—style by Herbert.

Herbert, whose parents were among the founders of the Berlin Kabarett in the 20's, established his own kabarett in Holland in the early 1930's. It flourished until the Nazi occupation when Herbert joined the Dutch resistance. Soon after World War II, he immigrated to the U.S. where he met and married singer Eva Nelson.

Herbert and Eva started their own intimate theater in 1958 at the Netherlands Club in Rockefeller Center for which Herbert wrote and produced a contemporary, satirical, literary show, introducing multi-media such as slides, tapes and film. They recorded one complete cabaret show and other cabaretistic material on Panorama Records, and their performances and records were acclaimed by critics. Most recently they have appeared at the Bert Wheeler Theater off-Broadway and at various clubs.

After the one- and one-half hour program, an informal get-together and discussion with refreshments will be hosted by the local German Club.

The cabaret is the next to last program of the two-week International Festival at Methodist College, and is sponsored by the Methodist College German Department, the German Club, Germany's Goethe Institute, and the North Carolina Southeastern Consortium for International Education.

ANNUAL CAMPAIGN FEB. 8

The Methodist College Foundation will launch its annual appeal in Cumberland County on February 8 with a kickoff banquet in the College Cafeteria.

Dr. Cameron West, president of the North Carolina Association of Independent Colleges and Universities, will be the guest speaker.

The Foundation is seeking \$120,000 in unrestricted gifts to fulfill the community's annual pledge dating back to the establishment of the College.

The board of directors is comprised of 32 persons from Fayetteville and Cumberland County. Ray A. Muench Jr., general manager of the Public Works Commission, is president and Joel Schur, general merchandise manager of the Capitol Department Stores, is chairman of the 1977 loyalty campaign.

The past year was the most successful Foundation effort in 15 years with gifts totaling \$157,515. In May total gifts to the College from Cumberland County surpassed an accumulated sum of \$2 million.

Gifts provide scholarship assistance for needy students, improve facilities, replace equipment and library books, and supplement faculty salaries.

More than 150 volunteers are expected to attend the kickoff banquet. Dr. West, North Carolina's top representative of independent education, is a graduate of the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill. He is a former director of the North Carolina Board of Higher Education and was a dean at Pfeiffer College.
