David was elected treasurer in the executive branch, and Scott was elected senator-at-large in the legislative branch. Both will serve during the 1977-78 academic year.

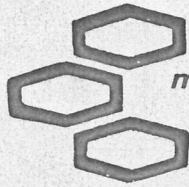
They are sons of Mr. and Mrs. Marden Perry, 133 Warthen Rd., Lexington.

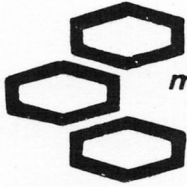

AT METHODIST COLLEGE

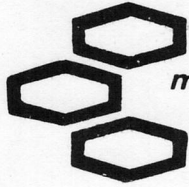
