METHODIST COLLEGE TO OFFER EXAMS IN DENTAL AUXILIARY FIELDS

FAYETTEVILLE--Methodist College announced today that four new examinations in the field of dental auxiliary education will be available June 14 and 15 as part of the College Level Examination Program (CLEP). CLEP is a national program of college credit by examination sponsored by the College Board.

Individuals who have acquired skills and knowledge in dental assisting, dental laboratory technology and dental hygiene can earn credit or advanced standing in college-level dental auxiliary programs through CLEP. The tests can help individuals advance more rapidly through a dental auxiliary curriculum, transfer more easily from one dental auxiliary field to another, and become certified or licensed in the dental field without duplication of training.

According to Prof. Earlyne Saunders, director of guidance and placement, the new 45-minute examinations are in oral radiography; head, neck and oral anatomy; tooth morphology and function; and dental materials.

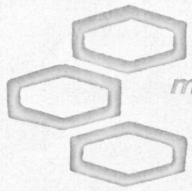
The new tests were developed under the joint auspices of the American Dental Association's council on dental education, the College Board, and the Educational Testing Service with funds from the Kellogg Foundation.

In addition to the new dental examinations, Methodist College offers individuals an opportunity to take CLEP examinations in 43 professional and college subjects, and five General Examinations in the liberal arts.
