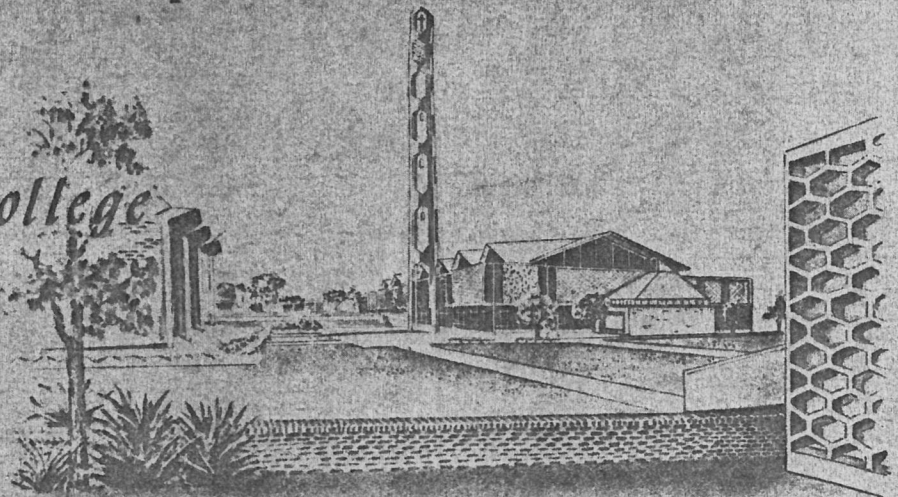

Your welcome to the Lions Club International in "Convention Time" effectively illustrated the increased role Fayetteville plays in the civic and church leadership of both state and region. Baptists, Presbyterians and Episcopalians have indeed chosen Fayetteville as a center for meetings within the past year. 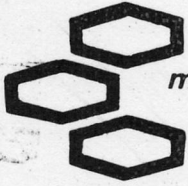
