**PULLIAM WINS NEH GRANT  
TO STUDY AMERICAN INDIAN**

FAYETTEVILLE--Bruce Pulliam, chairman of the department of social sciences at Methodist College, has been awarded a grant by the D'Archy McNickle Center for the History of the American Indian to attend a conference on the "Impact of Indian History on the Teaching of United States History."

Only sixty professors and editors across the nation were chosen to attend the conference which will be held on October 2-5 at the National Museum of American History of the Smithsonian Institute in Washington, DC.

Funded by the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH), the grant offers participants a chance to assimilate information concerning the teaching of Indian history within American History.

Pulliam begins his twenty-third year as a member of the Methodist College faculty where he currently serves as faculty marshal.

Fayetteville has the distinction of serving as the site of the largest private cheerleading camp in the nation--East Coast Cheerleading Camp, located on the campus of Methodist College. Offered only one week each summer, ECCC '85 will officially begin on Sunday afternoon, July 14, at 2:00 with Opening Convocation in Reeves Auditorium. Over 550 cheerleaders from North Carolina, South Carolina, Florida, Delaware and Virginia are registered for the week-long camp. A staff of 40, including college cheerleaders from UNC-Chapel Hill, NC State, East Carolina University, the University of South Carolina as well as host Methodist College cheerleaders, will provide intensive instruction in cheerleading technique, safety, mounts, dance, gymnastics and stunts.

Cheerleading has been in the news more in the past year than in the past century--in both positive and negative lights. National network coverage of college and high school cheerleading competitions brought the "new age of cheerleading" into homes complete with intricate stunts, flashy gymnastics and challenging mounts. National coverage of the near-fatal fall of Robin Davidson, UNC-CH junior varsity cheerleader, brought the dangers of cheerleading into clear and troubling focus.

Cheerleading will continue to be news for the next year or two as battles ensue over funding, liability, coaching supplements, and the very real problem of creating that delicate balance in cheerleading between performing and creating spirit. I invite you to be on the cutting edge of these changes--and there's no better place to get a feel for them than at East Coast Cheerleading Camp from July 14-July 19 at Methodist College. Enclosed you will find an ECCC Camper booklet which includes a daily schedule as well as additional information about the current status of cheerleading in the state.

Please call me if I can assist you in setting up interviews or arrange for you to sit in on any portion of the camp that interests you. ECCC is a recognized trendsetter in the philosophy that cheerleaders are athletes and in the belief that safety must be a primary concern for all cheerleading coaches. Emphasis on preventive safety and physical fitness is part of the ECCC instructional viewpoint. I hope that you will visit ECCC and see that philosophy at work.
