**METHODIST HONORS MARTHA DUELL**

Fayetteville, N.C. -- Methodist College recently honored Fayetteville civic leader Martha A. Duell by awarding her a Methodist College Medallion. College President Dr. M. Elton Hendricks presented the bronze medallion to Mrs. Duell during winter commencement exercises Dec. 17.

Mrs. Duell was cited for her work as founder and president of the Lafayette Society, for her "endless hours in establishing a closer bond between France and America," and for leading major fund-raising drives on behalf of Methodist College. A native of France, Mrs. Duell spearheaded the drive to establish the Lafayette Collection at Davis Memorial Library, helped establish a scholarship at Methodist for the sons and daughters of France, and raised funds for a grand piano for Reeves Auditorium.

The honoree currently serves on the Steering Committee for the Samuel Womack Endowed Chair in Religion and Philosophy and on the board of directors of the Methodist College Foundation. During 1986 alone, Mrs. Duell held the following positions: president of the Lafayette Society; president of the Lady Lions of Fayetteville; trustee and treasurer of the Woman's Club of Fayetteville, Inc.; co-chairman and treasurer of the International Folk Festival, vice president of the Cumberland County Historical Society; vice president of Friends of Davis Memorial Library; and treasurer of the Fayetteville Camellia Club. She also served on the boards of directors of Heritage Place and the Cumberland

**METHODIST TO OFFER COURSE  
ON NATIVE AMERICAN HISTORY**

FAYETTEVILLE, NC -- Methodist College will offer a course on the history of Native Americans in the 1987 spring semester. The course, a survey of the major Native American cultures of North America with emphasis on those in the eastern half of the United States, will be taught by Dr. Adolph L. Dial, chairman of the Department of American Indian Studies at Pembroke State University.

Dial, a former public school teacher and principal, has taught at Pembroke State since 1958. He is considered the leading authority on the Lumbee Indians and has published widely in the field.

The course will be offered on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to noon, beginning Jan. 17 and continuing through May 2, in Room 245 of the Trustees' Building on the Methodist campus. The course will offer three semester hours of credit or 4.5 CEU's/RC's.
