- During the Fall 1989 semester, Methodist served nearly 1,500 students representing 40 states and 20 foreign countries. Sixty-three percent of its students are from North Carolina. The college graduated 347 students during the 1988-89 school year.
- Methodist will soon dedicate a new \$3.8 million Physical Activities Center. Eight new tennis courts and a golf driving range were completed two years ago. The 600-acre campus now boasts some of the finest outdoor facilities anywhere, including a nature trail and a fitness trail.
- Eighty-three percent of the students at Methodist receive financial aid. Methodist believes in rewarding academic achievement and gives \$1.6 million annually in Incentive Scholarships. Based on SAT scores and class rank in high school, these scholarships range in value from \$1,500-\$5,500. The N. C. Legislative Tuition Grant of \$1,150 (for N. C. residents), loans and campus work ensure that a Methodist College education is well within the reach of most Tar Heel families.

Methodist College faculty members continue to distinguish themselves by presenting papers at national conferences, attending summer institutes, writing books, and winning grants.

Academic expectations are high. All degree candidates at Methodist must now pass proficiency tests in writing and speaking. The college has developed an Honors Program to challenge exceptional students. Methodist currently offers 37 degree programs.

The athletic program, with 16 intercollegiate sports and a core of young, award-winning coaches, has given the Monarchs national exposure by sending the baseball, softball, volleyball, soccer, and track teams to national tournaments.

Methodist is an NCAA Division III school and a member of the Dixie Conference. The college fielded its first football team during Fall 1989.

Thirty-six campus organizations afford Methodist College students innumerable opportunities to learn leadership and social skills and to grow as individuals. A well-balanced religious life program is coordinated by a campus minister.

College is committed to both tradition and flexibility. The college enters
