METHODIST COLLEGE AIMS FOR NATIONAL PRESENCE

① When Dr. ^{M.} Elton Hendricks assumed the presidency of Methodist College in the fall of 1983, he committed himself to the task of building a "national presence" for the college. The faculty, administration, and students are working hard to achieve this goal.

② Today there is a new pride and a new entrepreneurial spirit at Methodist College. "The administrators, faculty, staff, and most important of all, the students, sense the atmosphere of excitement and enthusiasm the college is generating," notes President Hendricks.

③ Methodist serves a wide range of students in its regular day program, Evening College, and summer school. ⁴ Its Computer-Assisted Composition program and nationally circulated Computer-Assisted Composition Journal have generated a ^{considerable} ~~great deal~~ of interest among academicians. The newly established Atlantic Coast Center for Language and Culture offers foreign students a unique, in-depth program in American studies. The Charles M. Reeves School of Business offers special concentrations in professional golf or tennis management.

→ During the Fall 1989 semester, Methodist ^{enrolled} ~~served~~ nearly 1,500 students representing 40 states and 20 foreign countries. Sixty-three percent of its students are from North Carolina. The college graduated ²⁴⁷ students during the 1988-89 school year.

⑤ Methodist will soon dedicate a new \$3.8 million Physical Activities Center. Eight new tennis courts and a golf driving range were completed two years ago. The 600-acre campus now boasts some of the finest outdoor facilities anywhere, including a nature trail and a fitness trail.

⑥ Eighty-three percent of the students at Methodist receive financial aid. Methodist believes in rewarding academic achievement and gives \$1.6 million annually in Incentive Scholarships. Based on SAT scores and class rank in high school, these scholarships range in value from \$1,500-\$5,500. The N. C. Legislative Tuition Grant of \$1,150 (for N. C. residents), loans and campus work ensure that a Methodist College education is well within the reach of most Tar Heel families.

An emphasis on Scholarship and good teaching combined with small classes and a strong adviser system enabled students to excel academically while attending the college

Methodist College faculty members continue to distinguish themselves by presenting papers at national conferences, attending summer institutes, writing books, and winning grants.

Academic expectations are high. All degree candidates at Methodist must now pass proficiency tests in writing and speaking. The college has developed an Honors Program to challenge exceptional students. Methodist currently offers 37 degree programs.

Guided by the motto "Veritas et Virtus"--Truth and Virtue--Methodist College is committed to both tradition and flexibility. The college enters ^{its} fourth decade determined to preserve the liberal arts base and spirit; to foster academic, spiritual, and physical growth in its students; and to prepare students for successful careers and lives of service to society.
