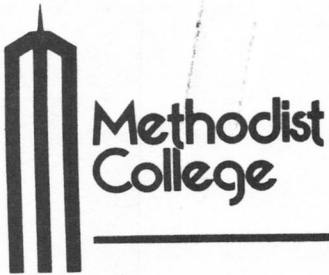

METHODIST COLLEGE TO PRESENT "FINIAN'S RAINBOW"

FAYETTEVILLE, NC--Methodist College will present the musical comedy "Finian's Rainbow" July 19, 20, and 21 at 8:00 p.m. in O'Hanlon Amphitheater on the college campus.

"Finian's Rainbow" is a fantasy about an Irishman, his daughter Sharon, and a leprechaun. The musical satirizes greed as practiced in America's rural South. The show features a large cast of local residents, directed by Alice Arrington, H. B. Hight, and Laura Potter.

Admission is \$6 for adults and \$2 for children and senior citizens. The rain date is Monday, July 23.

Daniel Freitas, a member of the chaplain's staff at Fort Bragg, plays the lead role of Finian. Victoria Royal plays Sharon, Finian's daughter. Jeff Poole plays Woody Mahoney, a sharecropper, and Allison Asbury plays Susan, Woody's mute sister.

"Finian's Rainbow" premiered on Broadway in 1947. Memorable songs from the show include "How Are Things In Glocca Morra?", "Look to the Rainbow", and "Old Devil Moon."

The show is based on a book by E. Y. Harburg and Fred Saidy. Burton Lane wrote the music and E. Y. Harburg wrote the lyrics.

SUMMER YOUTH THEATRE TO PRESENT "A LITTLE PRINCESS" AT METHODIST COLLEGE

FAYETTEVILLE, NC--Monarch Youth Theatre at Methodist College will present the drama "A Little Princess" Aug. 6, 7, and 8 at 7 p.m. in O'Hanlon Amphitheater. Tickets are \$2 for adults and \$1 for children.

Written by Virginia Glasgow Koste, "A Little Princess" is the story of an orphan girl forced into slavery by a sadistic school mistress. It takes place in London in 1895. The play was the basis for a movie starring Shirley Temple. It was also produced as a PBS special on public television several years ago.

Student Director Patrice Spangler said she selected the play because of its timeless appeal and the fact that it had parts for both children and adults. For background music, Ms. Spangler selected a recording of Gustav Holst's orchestral work "The Planets."

"A Little Princess" features Danielle Taylor and Wendy Wise as Sara Crewe (the heroine), Linda B. Greer as Miss Minchin (the wicked school mistress), Tim Callahan as Ram Das (an Indian servant), and Martin Smith as Mr. Carrisford (a friend of the heroine's father).

Other players include: Elbert Jackson Jr. as Captain Crewe, Mary Cathryn Murray as Mademoiselle DuFarge, Lisa Grantham as Emengarde St. John, Charis Glaude as Becky, and Heather Michelle Williams as Lavinia.
