

METHODIST COLLEGE TO OFFER THREE-WEEK COURSE/TRIP TO NEW YORK CITY

FAYETTEVILLE, NC -- Methodist College will offer a three-week communications course/trip entitled "Media in New York," Dec. 30 - January 17, 1992.

The three-semester hour course will include a week of study on the Methodist campus, followed by four days and nights in New York City, followed by a week at Methodist writing a term paper on some aspect of the New York communications media. Mr. Robert Bloodworth, Jr., assistant professor of communications, will teach the course.

Students will leave the college for New York January 7 and spend five nights at the Edison Hotel in the heart of the New York Theatre District. They will receive tickets to "Phantom of the Opera," an off-Broadway show, and the taping at a syndicated talk show. The tour will include visits to the Fashion Institute of Technology Costume Collection, NBC network facilities, a New York City TV production facility, and the New York Stock Exchange.

The cost of the course/trip ranges from \$769 (four-person occupancy) -- \$869 (double occupancy). Food and incidentals are not included in the package price. For persons who would like to take the course without college credit, the cost is \$499 (four-person occupancy) -- \$599 (double occupancy).

Mr. Robert Bloodworth, the instructor for the course, is a Fayetteville native who has lived and worked in New York City. From 1985-87 he was a writer/producer for Professional Communication Services, he also acted in several television soap operas. He holds an M.S. degree in Mass Communications/Drama from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.
