METHODIST COLLEGE MUSIC FACULTY TO GIVE MOZART RECITAL

FAYETTEVILLE, NC -- Seven members of the Methodist College music faculty will give an all-Mozart recital Tuesday, Oct. 15 at 8 p.m. in Reeves Auditorium. Admission is free.

This will be the second of three events planned for Methodist's observance of the 200th anniversary of the death of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. Faculty members will perform music for voice, piano, strings, and clarinet.

The performers and their specialties are: Teresa Batson (voice), Dr. Mary Frances Boyce (violin), Mrs. Joy Cogswell (piano), Mrs. Jane Weeks Gardiner (piano), Mrs. Diane Guthrie (voice), Mr. Alan M. Porter (voice), and Mr. J. Michael Rogers (woodwinds, piano, organ).

Teresa Huffman Batson holds degrees in Vocal Performance from Furman University and the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. She teaches private voice in the music department and is a leader in the music ministry at LaFayette Baptist Church in Fayetteville. She is active as a singer in the area but currently spends most of her time as a new mother.

Mary Frances Boyce is presently teaching strings and music history at Methodist College and performs with *Musica Della Collina* (Chapel Hill) and the Society for Performance on Original Instruments (Chapel Hill). As a recitalist, she has given concerts in Chapel Hill, Fayetteville, and Lincoln, Nebraska. In addition to a Ph.D. in Musicology from UNC-Chapel Hill, Ms. Boyce holds degrees from the Eastman School of Music and the University of Rochester. She studied baroque violin with Eduard Melkus, Marilyn MacDonald, and Richard Luby and has attended the Baroque Performance Institute at the Oberlin Conservatory.

Joy Cogswell is a graduate of Florida State University and has done graduate work at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro and at Meredith College in Raleigh. She is the Director of the Methodist College Preparatory School for the Performing Arts and also of the highly successful Methodist College Summer Music Camp. She is the pianist for Snyder Memorial Baptist Church and teaches private piano for Methodist College.

Jane Weeks Gardiner is an Assistant Professor of Music and teaches private piano, music theory, and music history. Her baccalaureate degree is from Salem College (*cum laude*) and she received the Master of Music degree in piano performance from the New England Conservatory of Music in Boston. In 1986 Jane was chosen to participate in the National Endowment for the Humanities Summer Seminar for College Teachers at Harvard University. Her Methodist College responsibilities have recently been expanded to include the position of Assistant to the Vice-President for Academic Affairs.

Diane Guthrie is currently teaching voice and music education at Methodist College. She holds a Master of Music degree in vocal performance from Florida State University and a Bachelor of Music from Queens College in Charlotte, N.C. Presently she is completing her dissertation for the degree Doctor of Musical Arts at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. She has performed extensively in recitals, oratorios, and operas, including the leading role in *La Traviata* by Verdi.

Alan M. Porter is currently Head of the Music Department and Director of the Division of Fine Arts. His degrees are from Mount Union College (B.M. *cum laude*) and the University of Illinois (M.M. with performance honors) with additional graduate study at Ball State University. During his sabbatical leave from the College during the Spring semester of 1991, he conducted an in-depth study of the life and music of Mozart in Europe and in this country, which culminated in the current Methodist College Mozart Celebration.

J. Michael Rogers is Assistant Professor of Music at Methodist College where he teaches music theory, music appreciation, composition, arranging, woodwinds, history and conducts the Stage Band. He holds both the B.S. in Music Education (*magna cum laude*) and the M.A. in Music Education from Appalachian State University. In addition to playing all woodwind instruments he is proficient as an organist, a pianist and a string bassist.

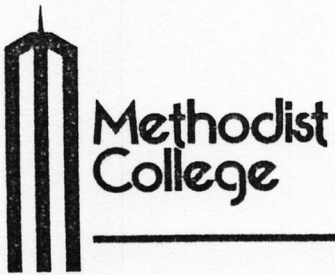

FAYETTEVILLE, NC -- Methodist College will offer a three-week communications course/trip entitled "Media in New York," Dec. 30 - January 17, 1992.

The three-semester hour course will include a week of study on the Methodist campus, followed by four days and nights in New York City, followed by a week at Methodist writing a term paper on some aspect of the New York communications media. Mr. Robert Bloodworth, Jr., assistant professor of communications, will teach the course.

Students will leave the college for New York January 7 and spend five nights at the Edison Hotel in the heart of the New York Theatre District. Mr. Robert Bloodworth, the instructor for the course, is a Fayetteville native who has lived and worked in New York City. From 1985-87 he was a writer/producer for Professional Communication Services, he also acted in several television soap operas. He holds an M.S. degree in Mass Communications/Drama from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.
