METHODIST COLLEGE RECEIVES REYNOLDS GRANT FOR PARENT EDUCATION PROGRAM

FAYETTEVILLE, NC--Methodist College has received a grant of \$25,305 from the Z. Smith Reynolds Foundation for a collaborative parent education program designed to improve the reading skills of disadvantaged fourth graders.

The grant will support a five-month instructional program for parents of fourth graders at Pauline Jones Elementary School in Fayetteville. The school serves approximately 220 pupils in grades 4-6 and has a high percentage of economically disadvantaged students who are reading below grade level.

Dubbed SPIRIT--Students and Parents Involved in Reading Instruction Together--the program will offer monthly workshops along with free books and a magazine that parents can take home to read with their children. The program will be co-directed by Ms. Jennifer Jerch, English and education instructor at Methodist College, and Mrs. Barbara Rice, a fourth grade teacher at Pauline Jones Elementary School.

The proposal for the Z. Smith Reynolds grant was written by three educators--Sally Austin, principal of Pauline Jones Elementary School; Dr. Tony DeLapa, professor of education at Methodist College; and Ms. Jennifer Jerch, instructor of education and English at Methodist.

Dr. DeLapa said he and his two colleagues spent "many, many hours" developing the SPIRIT project. "We're very pleased that we can give something back to the community and help these kids," he said.

The SPIRIT program begins January 7, 1992 and marks the third time that Methodist College has reached out to Pauline Jones Elementary School. The

partnership began last school year when the school principal asked Dr. DeLapa to conduct an inservice reading workshop for teachers. After the workshop, Dr. DeLapa persuaded Mrs. Austin to allow Methodist faculty and staff to offer a summer reading camp for incoming fourth graders at Pauline Jones. After the reading camp was held, Dr. DeLapa and his colleagues decided to apply for a grant to involve parents in teaching their children to read.

"Forty-eight parents are already signed up for SPIRIT," said Daisy Steward, PTA president at Pauline Jones. "I think this will make a great difference. The parents can't say 'No' now." The program will offer a small stipend to parents for travel to and from the workshops, furnish child care for those who need it, and even provide refreshments. The school-based workshops will be offered during the day and at night.

The five monthly sessions will be conducted by educational specialists from the college and the Cumberland County school system. Topics will include: What You Can Do at Home, Positive Parenting Techniques, Reading Without Books, What's at the Library? and Ideas for Vocabulary Development. At each session parents will choose three trade books to take home to read with their children. Project members will be on call to offer additional assistance at the parents' request.

The \$25,000 Reynolds grant will also pay for two microcomputers with reading software and two reading scanners, trade books, and a special magazine subscription for each fourth grader. Methodist College and Pauline Jones Elementary School will furnish an additional \$5,740 for support staff and child care services.

After the training sessions end, the parents and their children will be asked to sign ^a contract in which they agree to engage in reading at least ten minutes [^] each evening for three months. At the end of the school year, parents and

educators will evaluate the SPIRIT program through questionnaires and interviews. The 1992 California Achievement Test scores of fourth graders whose parents have participated in the SPIRIT program will be analyzed to determine the effect of the project.

Methodist College and the other project members are committed to continuing the summer reading camp and the parent training program for Pauline Jones fourth graders beyond the current school year. They plan to seek permanent funding from a combination of local agencies, civic groups, and businesses.
