STATE PRISON DIRECTOR TO SPEAK AT METHODIST COLLEGE

FAYETTEVILLE, NC -- The Director of North Carolina Prisons and the former Secretary of Corrections will discuss prison overcrowding and other issues confronting the state correctional system Wednesday, April 15 at Methodist College.

Joseph L. Hamilton, Director of Prisons, will speak at a free public forum at 8 p.m. in Reeves Auditorium.

Mr. Hamilton is from Fayetteville and attended Methodist College. He has been Director of Prisons since 1987. Mr. Hamilton will be accompanied by Aaron Johnson, who served as N.C. Secretary of Corrections from 1985 until this year.

Mr. Hamilton and Mr. Johnson will discuss: the current status of the state's prison building program approved by voters two years ago, whether new prison construction will be adequate to solve current overcrowding, and other actions needed to solve North Carolina's "corrections dilemma."

As the news media have reported, North Carolina prisons are so crowded that when a newly convicted felon is imprisoned, another must usually be released to make room. Federal officials monitor the state's prison population closely to insure compliance with federal laws.

The upcoming forum on prison problems is being offered under the auspices of the Criminal Justice/Legal Studies Program at Methodist. This new interdisciplinary major is available in both the day and evening college programs. For more information, contact Dr. Suzan Cheek, Program Coordinator, at 630-7065.

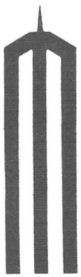

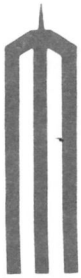

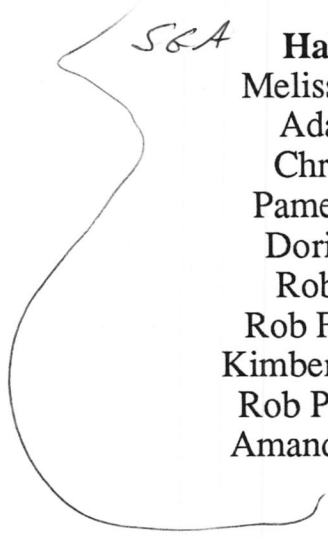
