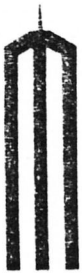

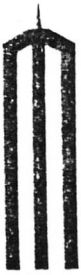

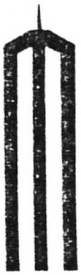

METHODIST COLLEGE RECEIVES \$200,000 BEQUEST

FAYETTEVILLE, NC -- Methodist College recently received a \$200,000 bequest from the estate of Virginia McKenzie Reeves of Pinehurst. Mrs. Reeves died March 23, 1992.

Mrs. Reeves was the widow of John Mercer Reeves, a textile manufacturer, former Methodist College trustee and philanthropist.

The Reeves Auditorium/Fine Arts Building at Methodist College is named for Mr. Reeves, who was its principal benefactor. Mr. Reeves died March 16, 1976 at the age of 89.

The Methodist College Board of Trustees directed that Mrs. Reeves' bequest be placed in the college's quasi-endowment. The funds will earn interest, but will also be available for special needs.
