FAYETTEVILLE, NC—The Methodist College Chorus and the Pine Forest Senior High School Chorus will join forces for a winter concert of great choral music Wednesday, Dec, 2 at 8 p.m. in Reeves Auditorium. Admission is free and the public is invited.

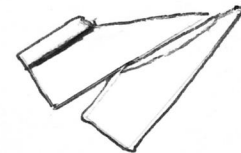

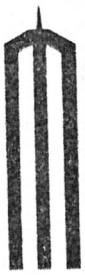
