METHODIST COLLEGE LAUNCHES WEEKEND PROGRAM

FAYETTEVILLE, N.C.-Methodist College will launch a program of weekend classes Jan. 10, 1997. Six courses will be offered initially, with classes meeting for five hours and 15 minutes—on either Friday evenings or Saturday mornings—for a total of eight weeks.

The Weekend Program will give nontraditional students an alternative to the normal Evening College pattern where courses are taught in either Monday-Wednesday or Tuesday-Thursday combinations, with classes meeting for two and a half hours each night, beginning at either 5:30 or 8:10 p.m.

For Weekend Spring Term I, the Friday courses are: English 100, English 101, and Sociology 151; classes begin at 5 p.m. and end at 10:15 p.m. The Saturday morning courses are: History 101, Religion 103, and Math 103; classes begin at 8:30 a.m. and end at 1:45 p.m.

Weekend Spring Term I is scheduled for Jan. 10-March 1. Weekend Spring Term II will be held March 15-May 3. Courses scheduled for Term II are: English 101, English 102, and Political Science 151, meeting on Fridays; and Math 105, Religion 104, and History 102, meeting on Saturdays.

METHODIST COLLEGE GRADUATES 120 AT 24TH WINTER COMMENCEMENT

FAYETTEVILLE, NC—Methodist College graduated 120 students at its 24th winter commencement December 13.

Dr. Sue Kimball, retired Methodist College English professor, delivered the commencement address, entitled "Everything You Need To Know You Learned At Methodist College."

Dr. Kimball offered the graduates seven rules for successful living which she said they should have learned at Methodist College. They are: 1)Be curious, 2)Never go anywhere without a ball point pen, 3)Never go anywhere without a paperback book or magazine, 4)Don't worry about what others think about you, 5)Love yourself, 6) Find a cause and get behind it, and 7)Listen with an open heart and mind to those who love you the most.

In his baccalaureate sermon Friday morning, Rev. Bill Braswell, pastor of Haymount United Methodist Church in Fayetteville, urged the graduates to be "people of joy in all seasons and circumstances." His sermon topic was based on I Thessalonians 5:16-18.

While conceding that Advent can be a joy-robbing season in some ways, Rev. Braswell said, "Don't let despair defeat you. Find some way to beat the blues. Do something positive for someone else. Joy is the natural emotion for the Christian."

College President Elton Hendricks presented Methodist College Medallions to two retired faculty members—Mrs. Inge Dent, who taught German for 27 years and served 14 years as dean of women; and Dr. Sue Kimball, who taught English for 17 years and directed the College's Southern Writers' Symposium.

President Hendricks also presented the Sam Edwards Award to Mrs. Mary Francis Williams of Roseboro, N. C., denoting her selection as the outstanding Evening College graduate of 1996. Mrs. Williams graduated "magna cum laude" in May, with a B.S. degree in business administration.

Twenty-six members of the winter class graduated with honors—nineteen "cum laude," five "magna cum laude," and two "summa cum laude."
