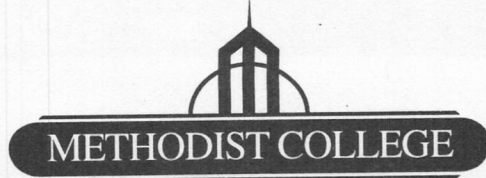

METHODIST COLLEGE TO STAGE 'SWEETHEART 5K ROAD RACE'

FAYETTEVILLE, NC—The Student Activities Committee at Methodist College will stage a Sweetheart 5K Road Race Saturday, Feb. 13 on campus. Runners from Fayetteville and other communities in southeastern North Carolina are invited to compete.

The twelve entry categories include a One-Mile Fun Run for children, and special events for couples, five-man teams, and five-woman teams. Winners in each category will receive Nike running shoes and all runners will receive "Sweetheart 5K" T-shirts. First, Second, and Third Place finishers in each category will receive trophies.

"We are promoting this to runners throughout the Sandhills," said Chris Ryan, director of student activities. "We feel it offers something for everyone and we hope it will become an annual event. The proceeds will benefit the Student Activities Committee and the Monarch Booster Club."

"We also see this as a way to bring people out to Methodist," said Tim Christ, president of the Student Activities Committee. "Our track coach and track team and members of the Student Athletic Association have laid out the course and will be working as volunteers on race day."

The starting times are 8:30 a.m. for the One-Mile Fun Run and 9 a.m. for the 5K Race. Both events will start and conclude at the soccer field. The pre-registration fees are \$12 for the 5K race, \$6 for the One-Mile Fun Run, and \$50 for each Five-Man or Five-Woman team. Fees for those who register on race day (no later than 7:45 a.m.) are: \$15 for the 5K race, \$10 for the One-Mile Fun Run, and \$60 for each Five-Man or Five-Woman team.

AFRICAN-AMERICAN HISTORIAN TO SPEAK AT METHODIST COLLEGE

FAYETTEVILLE, NC—Dr. Wilma King, professor of history at Michigan State University, will deliver the spring convocation address at Methodist College Monday, Feb. 1. Her address is entitled "Recent Trends in African American History." The public is invited.

Dr. King's speech, set for 11 a.m. in Reeves Auditorium, is also the kickoff event for Methodist's observance of Black History Month. Dr. King will discuss recent changes in how historians understand the experience of slavery and freedom among African Americans. She is the author of *Stolen Childhood: Youth in Bondage in Nineteenth-Century America* published by Indiana University Press.

Dr. King taught history at Fayetteville State University before going to Hampton University, Indiana University of Pennsylvania, and Michigan State University. She holds Ph.D. and M.A. degrees in American History from Indiana University and a B.A. in American History from Jackson State University. Her research has won prizes from the National Conference of Black Political Scientists and the Association of Black Women Historians.

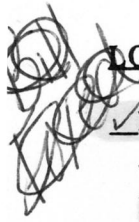
