

Approximately 45 academic scholarships are available. All scholarships are awarded for one year and are to be used exclusively for payment of college fees. Application for renewel must be filled each succeeding academic year.

Interested students should read thoroughly the scholarship section of the current bulletin. In addition to taking the scholarship examination, students should submit an application for admission, verify actual need, have good high school records, and have good recommendations.
