



Methodist College moved ahead on many fronts in 1999. The College opened two new buildings funded by the *Expanding the Vision* Campaign. Margaret and Walter Clark Hall gave the Reeves School of Business a new, state-of-the-art academic facility, with its own computer lab and a small auditorium. The new wing of Davis Memorial Library and improvements to the original building provided new reference and study areas, a Special Collections Room, and 20 additional computer stations for students.

In the academic area, Methodist was recommended and approved for reaffirmation of accreditation by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. In athletics, the men's and women's golf teams again won their respective national championships. The Athletic Hall of Fame inducted its second class.

On behalf of the Methodist College Board of Trustees, I would like to thank the administration, faculty and staff for all their hard work. These achievements and those of Methodist students and alumni are a constant source of inspiration to us. Through its 7,097 graduates, Methodist College has become a great force for good in our community, state, nation and world.

In the Fayetteville area, Methodist College remains a major economic and cultural asset. The bulk of its \$24 million budget is spent locally, while its 2,000 students and 294 full-time employees constitute a major block of consumers. Special events at Methodist—symposia, concerts and summer camps—draw thousands of people to the campus. Faculty, staff and students give many hours of volunteer service to the Fayetteville area.

Because Methodist is tuition-driven and has a relatively small endowment, gifts and grants are needed to keep pace with recent enrollment growth and new programs. To the hundreds of friends and alumni whose gifts have endowed scholarships, helped fund new buildings, or underwritten new programs, I offer my heartfelt thanks. Your support has made a tremendous difference in the last decade, and continued growth will require even more in the years ahead.

On the eve of the 21st century, let's resolve to keep Methodist College a place of honor and distinction, a school that prepares people of all ages and backgrounds to go forth and do great things in our world. I am proud to be associated with Methodist College, and I am excited about its future.



From the president

Dear Friends,

During 1999, Methodist College was blessed in many ways. With the opening of Margaret and Walter Clark Hall and the addition to Davis Memorial Library, the campus grew to 28 buildings. These facilities were made possible by gifts to the *Expanding the Vision* Campaign.

In February, the Board of Trustees approved a Strategic Plan for 2000-2005, which included five general recommendations and 27 specific recommendations for improving college programs and facilities. In April, the College was visited by the Reaffirmation Committee of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, which issued three commendations, sixteen recommendations, and nine suggestions. The Committee commended Student Life for its residential programming, our Professional Golf and Tennis Management programs, and the trustees for strengthening the College's financial condition.

In athletics, Methodist was most successful in men's and women's golf—repeating as national champions—and in women's softball, where the team went undefeated in the Dixie Conference and won its first-ever NCAA Regional bid. In addition, four of our athletes won All-America honors last year, and Methodist placed 13th out of 357 schools in the Sears Director's Cup competition, based on the overall success of its athletic program.

As we began our 40th academic year in August, we launched the ARRIVED (American-Russian Regional Institute for Visionary Entrepreneur Development) program and awarded full scholarships to four Russian students who will earn business degrees and return home to promote the free enterprise system. The fall semester also brought record residential enrollment of 759 students and a record total enrollment of 1,972.

In October, Methodist College was recognized in a guidebook published by the John Templeton Foundation for its efforts to promote character development. The guide described our Honor Code and efforts by the Faculty and Collegiality and Development Group to enrich the Honors Program, the B. F. Stone Endowed Lyceum and the MC Marquee Program.

Last December, we learned that the Southern Association had reaffirmed our accreditation. We also reached another milestone by graduating our 7,000th student! Imagine the positive difference that 7,097 Methodist College graduates are making in our community, state, nation and world! To all our friends, but especially to members of the North Carolina Conference of the United Methodist Church and to residents of Fayetteville and Cumberland County, I salute and thank you for making this milestone possible. Your vision, hard work and generous gifts have made Methodist College a great place to live and learn.

As we begin the 21st century, academic excellence and spiritual development remain our central focus. In the years ahead, enrollment growth and rapid technological change will pose special challenges for Methodist College, but if we continue to work together—staff, students, friends and alumni—I believe we can take the College to a new level of excellence. That is my goal, and I urge all who believe in "Truth and Virtue" to climb aboard!

Cademic Affairs

he library staff occupied the new addition to Davis Memorial Library in May. Although it took most of the summer to prepare the addition for student use, it was ready for the students when they arrived on campus for the Fall '99 semester.

The reaffirmation visit was conducted by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools in April. After we submitted the follow-up report in September, SACS notified Methodist College of its reaffirmation of accreditation. The reaffirmation visit proved to be better than anticipated, particularly the three commendations received by the College.

The 15th Southern Writers Symposium, originally scheduled for September 17th and 18th, was cancelled due to inclement weather. This is always a premier event on the campus, and everyone was disappointed when the weather necessitated the cancellation.

The four Russian students who were awarded full academic scholarships in business administration arrived to initiate the College's new ARRIVED program. The American-Russian Regional Institute for Visionary Entrepreneur Development program became a reality with its goal to promote free enterprise and entrepreneurship in Russia by training some of its future business leaders.

The third annual B.F. Stone Endowed Lyceum was held March 23, 1999, in the Yarborough Auditorium, Margaret & Walter Clark Hall. Dr. Donald

Lassiter, associate professor of psychology, presented a paper entitled "Aging and Driving: The Need for Improved Driver's License Testing." This presentation sparked a lively debate with strong opinions on both sides of the aisle.

Several new faculty members were hired during 1999: Stephen "Pete" Petersen became the director of the professional tennis management

program. Hugh Harley accepted the position of director of the athletic training program.

Todd Lyden, a graduate of Methodist College, assumed the responsibilities of debate coach and academic advisor. Dr. Stephanie Westmyer accepted the position of assistant professor of speech. Dr. John Fields was appointed an assistant professor of chemistry. Dr. Carl Dyke joined the History and Political Science Department as an assistant professor of history. Mr. Ronnie Martin was appointed the director of the social work program. Dr. Richard Hall was appointed an assistant professor of religion and philosophy.

Kyle King assumed the position of Assistant Dean for Institutional Research. Dr. David Gunto, cataloging/special collections librarian, and Katie Stottlemeyer, reference librarian, joined the library staff. Darlene Morgan accepted the position of academic advisor.

Robin Greene, assistant professor of English at Methodist College, gave a public reading of her recently-published book, entitled *Real Birth: Women Share Their Stories*, in November 1999 at the Arts Center in downtown Fayetteville.

The first Nimocks Endowed Professorship, established in 1997 with a gift from Fayetteville businessman David R. Nimocks, Jr., and family, was awarded to Dr. Jen-Hsiang Lin, professor of economics in the Reeves School of Business and director of the school's Institute for Business and Marketing Research. The professorship provides an annual salary supplement to be used for programming, teaching materials, or professional development. The appointment is for five years.

In addition to the faculty who presented papers or moderated sessions at meetings, Academic Affairs provided funds for seven faculty to attend conferences for the purpose of broadening their expertise in their fields.

Goals for 2000

- Continue to promote student success by enhancing academic support services such as the Academic Development Center and the Writing Center.
- Focus on enrollment management and the retention of entering freshmen.
- Improve assessment strategies of all educational programs and promote the use of results for improving student learning.
- Assess the general education core curriculum and use assessment results to improve the effectiveness of core II courses.
- Develop strategies for improving the Student Information System to enhance research efforts.
- Implement a master's level program for the Physician Assistant Program by fall 2001 and carefully evaluate proposals for additional graduate programs.

Business Affairs

he Office of Business Affairs was involved in several major initiatives last year. Last summer we submitted a lengthy application to the Higher Education Facilities Finance Agency and the Local Government Commission in Raleigh for authority to issue tax-free revenue bonds. After an extensive review process, we were approved for a \$14.2 million bond issue.

The bond proceeds will be used for the following projects:

- -\$8 million to refinance existing debt.
- —\$3.5 million for a new residence hall that will accommodate 68 students and an area coordinator.
 - -\$800,000 for the renovation of science labs.
 - ---\$700,000 to buy 33 acres of land adjacent to the campus.
- —\$600,000 to renovate the four original residence halls (Cumberland, Garber, Sanford, Weaver).

—\$600,000 for contingencies and issuance cost.

Other major initiatives included the hiring of a purchasing agent, the completion of a new Staff Policy Manual, the purchase of a 33-acre tract of land next to the campus for improved access to the south campus, the award of a construction contract for a new 68-student residence hall, and completion of a new entrance and stoplight for College Centre Office Park at Stacy Weaver Drive.

Last summer, we renovated 45 rooms in Weaver and Cumberland halls, installed four emergency call boxes on campus, and added a backflow valve on the main water line into the campus. We also made minor repairs and improvements to our older campus buildings and grounds.

- Renovate 100 dormitory rooms in Sanford and Weaver halls.
- Renovate and refurbish three or four laboratories in the Science Building.
- Complete construction of a 68-student, apartment-style residence hall and community building.
- Repair and paint the exterior of Cumberland, Sanford, Garber and Weaver residence halls.

Student Life

P or Student Life, 1999 was a year of building upon successful programs and implementing innovative ideas.

In the fall, occupancy in the residence halls reached an all-time high of 759 as compared to 704 the previous fall. While there was a slight increase in the number of new students, the number of returning students was higher than ever

The increase in occupancy is also related to improved service provided to resident students. The residence life staff has provided more frequent and higher quality programming for students. We have also continued implementation and training regarding the departmental Code of Ethics, which was created in 1998. In addition, the Residence Life Staff Association was created as a forum for resident advisors to provide feedback and suggestions to residence life professional staff members.

The Office of Career Services created a new Web site in 1999 (www.methodist.edu/careerservices) that includes an online job recruitment system, updated information on upcoming events such as workshops, job fairs, and on-campus recruitment opportunities, information on career assessments and graduate school testing, information specific to employers, information for alumni, and links to job listings and career assistance.

In addition, the career center added a new computer with software designed

to assist in the development of resumés and cover letters. This software also includes a virtual interview and the ability to upload resumés to every major resumé bank on the Internet. The Career Center experienced increases in the number of students being served, the number of career development workshops offered, and the number of recruiters coming to campus.

The Counseling Center continued to experience increases in the number of students utilizing its services. In 1999, more students than ever were served. A new focus of the center has been the creation of the SUCCESS! Project, which is co-sponsored by the Lura S. Tally Center for Leadership Development. Through this project, students are identified as potential leaders and nominated by faculty and staff to participate. They are then invited to a dinner in their honor and also invited to participate in a weekend workshop to assist them in developing their leadership potential. The Counseling Center also provided more effective outreach to resident students by recruiting and training residential peer counselors. There is at least one residential peer counselor living in each residence hall, who is available to residents at all hours.

Improvements were made in the area of Health Services. The health clinic is open one evening each week, and the evening appointments increased in 1999. A campus-wide flu vaccine was offered and the Hepatitis B vaccine was given to staff members to meet OSHA requirements. In addition, there is an ongoing process to update both medicines and equipment.

The public safety department counts among its accomplishments a crime stoppers column in the *Monarch Messenger* and expanded community policing efforts, including the new emergency call boxes on campus. Additional crime prevention, rape prevention and CPR certification classes were offered. Two security officers completed training to become certified to teach the Rape Aggression Defense curriculum. Equipment was purchased to enhance training. A number of police officers achieved higher certification levels and completed various training programs.

The Religious Life program continues to provide opportunities for students, faculty and staff to engage in worship, study, fellowship, prayer and service. The Rev. Carl King became our campus minister. Participation in Wednesday worship services has increased; guest preachers and non-traditional music selections have been incorporated.

The Gospel Choir was created and has added special music to worship services. This group meets weekly and sings during worship monthly. The choir will soon take its show on the road. Campus Ministry sponsored a climbing wall during Family Weekend, which provided a wonderful opportunity for campus outreach and publicized the various religious life activities.

Enrollment Services

n upward enrollment trend continued at Methodist College in 1999, and the College began the fall semester with 1,974 students.

The regular day program and the residential enrollment both set new records. The College also witnessed dramatic growth in the Evening College. The College began its 40th academic year with a student body that represented 46 states and 23 foreign countries.

The freshman class included 104 Incentive Scholars. This academic scholarship recognizes high school students who have an outstanding academic background. These students represent 27% of our freshmen class. The GPA/SAT average of our Incentive Scholarship recipients was 3.49/1101.

In 1999-2000, the College awarded over \$5 million in institutional aid to its students. We remain committed to providing a strong and proactive financial aid program. In addition to academic awards, the College offers a wide variety of grants and scholarships that are designated for students who have demonstrated financial need. Each year this comprehensive aid program makes the dream of attending Methodist College a reality for many deserving students.

The Office of Enrollment Services would like to thank the many alumni, United Methodist friends, college faculty, staff, and coaches who played such a major role in making 1999 a successful recruitment year. Your willingness to share your "MC Story" with prospective students and their families is extremely beneficial. Let's continue to work together to ensure a bright enrollment future at Methodist College.







Institutional Advancement

hanks to many generous supporters, 1999 was very rewarding for the Office of Institutional Advancement. Two events stand out—the February dedication of Margaret and Walter Clark Hall and the Oct. 31 open house for the new wing of Davis Memorial Library. These were the keystone projects of the *Expanding the Vision* Campaign which ended in 1998.

In February, we kicked off our Annual Fund Drive, with Lyndo Tippett serving as honorary Loyalty Day Chairman. Loyalty Fund receipts were used to supplement the operating budget. We again honored our major donors with a Donor Recognition Banquet.

In March, we produced our first "annual report" in *Methodist College Today*. In April, we held a Scholarship Luncheon that brought together the donors of endowed scholarships and the students who were current recipients thereof. This is our way of thanking those benefactors who are helping to make a Methodist College education possible for many students.

In July, our Public Relations Office prepared and distributed a new "One-Minute Look at Methodist College," an "Expect the Best" rack piece, and a mass mailer card advertising Evening College. These were followed in the fall by a Speakers Bureau brochure, a new postcard, a new Christmas card, a new 30-second TV commercial, and a Faculty Source Book. The PR Office also sent out 6,238 press releases last year and placed more than 100 print and broadcast ads for a variety of college programs and events.

In August, Mike Molter '94 joined our staff as the College's first full-time webmaster. By the end of the year, the MC Web site had grown to over 1,000 pages and the quality had improved dramatically. Faculty and staff in almost every department worked very hard last year to build "snappy" Web pages and we are grateful for that.

Jami Sheppard, our new Director of Student Media, hit the ground running and the student newspaper staff changed the newspaper's name to MONARCH MESSENGER. Jami recruited many new staff members for the newspaper and yearbook staffs and the paper went "on-line"—as part of the MC Web

site-in October.

In September our annual alumni phonathon was curtailed somewhat by Hurricane Floyd, which flooded large areas of eastern North Carolina. The last weekend in October brought another successful homecoming built around the theme "Still Crazy After All These Years."

As the year ended, we developed and posted Web pages outlining ways to make gifts to Methodist and welcomed Tom Maze as alumni director and Kirsten Pue as development associate. On the heels of the most successful comprehensive campaign in the College's history, we began a feasibility study to explore possibilities and opportunities for the next major fund-raising initiative. Thanks again to all the volunteers and donors who made 1999 another great year for Methodist College.

As 1999 came to a close, the Methodist College Athletic Department had run out of trophy case space. Our coaches and athletes achieved a great deal last year.

Basketball seasons concluded in late February with the Lady Monarchs earning a co-championship in the Dixie Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The men's team finished second in the Dixie's regular season and made it to the finals of the conference tournament held at Averett College.

Our spring sports had the most productive seasons. Both the men's and women's golf teams claimed national championships, as the men's team won the Division III trophy in convincing fashion and the women's team won the Division II and III trophy in a come-from-behind charge. Men's golfer Chad Collins was the NCAA National Champion and was named as a First Team All-American. On the women's side, both Tracy Gage and Tanice Nilson were named as First Team All-Americans.

The baseball team finished the season 29-13 and won the Dixie regular season title in dramatic fashion with a sweep of nationally-ranked NC Wesleyan on the road.

In all, the spring sports at Methodist College earned four All-American honors, two NCAA national championships, three Dixie Conference Championships, 22 All-Conference honors, three Conference Player of the Year honors, and one Coach of the Year honor.

The calendar year also saw the Methodist College Athletic Hall of Fame grow from seven to 11 inductees with the November induction of four well-deserving Monarchs.

To wrap up the 1999 athletic year, Methodist College placed 13th out of 357 in the Sears Director's Cup Trophy which recognizes overall athletic program success among all Division-III schools. The 13th place finish is the highest in school history and was the highest of any South region and Dixie Conference school.

Church & Community Relations

The Office of Church and Community Relations played host to more than 60,000 visitors in 1999. People came to Methodist College for church meetings, concerts, lectures, athletic events and summer camps. Reeves Auditorium and the Alumni Dining Room in the Berns Student Center were used extensively.

The Methodist College Clergy Friends Association and the separate Laity Friends Association met twice last year. United Methodist ministers were invited to our fall and spring Pastor's Days, which are scheduled to coincide with the Womack Endowed Lectures. Last July several Laity Friends helped paint stairwells and doors in Cumberland and Sanford halls.



Dr. Thomas S. Yow, III


Dr. Thomas S. Yow, III, the current president of Young Harris College in Young Harris, GA, has had a distinguished career in higher education, holding important administrative posts at four different United Methodist

Dr. Yow is a 1966 graduate of Methodist College, where he earned a B.A. in History and Religion. After graduating from Methodist, he became a United Methodist minister, serving three different churches in the North Carolina

Conference. He subsequently earned Doctor of Education and Master of Divinity degrees from Duke University.

From 1985-91, he served as president of Martin Methodist College in Pulaski, TN. During his tenure there, enrollment grew 57 percent and the college endowment doubled. From 1977-85, he was assistant to the president of Louisburg College. From 1973-77, he was director of admissions and financial aid at Methodist College.

Since becoming president of Young Harris College in 1991, Dr. Yow has assumed numerous leadership positions in his community and state. He currently chairs the Association of Private Colleges and Universities of Georgia and serves on the Georgia Student Finance Commission and the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. Methodist College awarded him the Distinguished Alumni Award in 1985 and an honorary Doctor of Divinity degree in 1989. Louisburg College awarded him a President's Medallion in 1985. He was named to Who's Who in America for five consecutive years, from 1992-96.

The Reverend Michael W. Safley, a 1972 graduate of Methodist College, lives a life devoted to the cause of nurturing and loving children and youth. This calling is evident in his life journey by the roads he has willfully chosen to travel.

Mike Safley holds a B.A. in English and History from Methodist College, with a double minor in religion and philosophy. He earned his Master of Divinity, with a concentration in Clinical Pastoral Education, from Duke

University in 1975.

Reverend Safley became president of the Methodist Home for Children in July 1997. He served as the chaplain and area supervisor for the agency from 1975-78 and was a member of the home's Board of Trustees from 1985-92.

From its headquarters in Raleigh, NC, The Methodist Home for Children operates twelve group homes for children across North Carolina, as well as emergency homes and shelters and seven juvenile detention facilities. The agency will soon open a new Child and Family Enrichment Center adjacent to its headquarters.

Prior to his current ministry, the Reverend Safley served: ten years as vice president for student affairs and dean of students at his alma mater, Methodist College; five years as associate director of the North Carolina Conference Council on Ministries; and four years as pastor of Middleburg United Methodist Church. He is an ordained elder in the North Carolina Conference of the United Methodist Church. In 1998, he received the Methodist College Alumni Association's Distinguished Alumni Award.

THE 20% BY 2000 INITIATIVE!

What is 20% by 2000? Endorsed by the Methodist College Alumni Association Board of Directors, this initiative is an effort to reach and sustain 20% of active alumni support by the end of 2000. Last year we were at 15%.





Cast

The most common way to support Methodist College is through a gift of cash which is deductible for income tax purposes in the year of the contribution.

Securities

The contribution of long-term appreciated securities enables you to claim an income tax charitable deduction for the full present fair market value, and you can avoid capital gains taxes on the appreciation.

Real Estate

An outright gift of property enables you to claim an income tax charitable deduction equal to the property's fair market value (if held long-term). Also, you avoid possible capital gains taxes on the property's appreciation.

Insurance

By naming Methodist College as the owner and beneficiary of a paid-up policy, you are entitled to an income tax deduction generally equal to the replacement value or cost basis of the policy, whichever is less. If you continue paying the premium on a policy you donate to Methodist, you may claim the premium amount as an annual tax deduction.

Gift Annuity

A charitable gift annuity is a contract between the donor and Methodist College whereby the donor transfers assets to the College and receives fixed payments for his/her life or for that of another beneficiary. The payment amount is determined by your age at the time of your contribution.

Charitable Remainder Trusts

Remainder trusts are life income arrangements whereby assets are gifted to the trust, which in turn pays the donor or his/her beneficiary a regular income for life. The donated assets can be cash, securities, or property, and at the time of the gifts, potential tax reduction benefits accrue to the donor. After the death of the last income beneficiary, the trust assets revert to Methodist College to be used according to the donor's prior wishes.
